



ChlorSeptic 2% and 4% with Aloe Vera

Question: Aloe Vera Toxicity in Dogs and Cats

The Aloe Vera plant if eaten by animals has mild to moderate toxicity in pets. The primary effects are gastrointestinal.

The purified Aloe Vera fraction in ChlorSeptic 2 and 4 percent is a purified Aloe Vera glycoprotein Fraction which is generally recognized as safe for topical use. The inclusion rate in the product is less than one percent and if the animal licks the treated area after application of the product the total exposure will be extremely low.

The Aloe Vera extract is included in the product to enhance skin health and feel following repeated use of the product primarily on the hands. It is in combination with two other skin enhancers. These reduce dryness and cracking typically seen with other surgical scrub products.

What are the uses of aloe vera for the skin?
