DIRECTIONS FOR USE

The 16 oz. bottle comes with a trigger sprayer. For refills, pour the 32 oz. bottle or 1 gallon into the spray bottle dialed to a spray pattern. Hold sprayer about 4–6 inches from area to be treated. Spray 1 or more times - allow to dry. Repeat as needed. Forms a highly visible coating that is durable.

WARNINGS

Do not use in the eyes. Do not use if you are allergic to povidone-iodine. Prolonged exposure may cause irritation. If swallowed, get medical help or contact a Poison Control Center right away.

Store at 20° - 25° C (68°–77° F). Excursions permitted between 15° - 30° C (59° - 86° F). Avoid inhalation.

Flammable - use with caution. For external use only. Keep out of reach of children. Wet hair or fur is flammable.
